Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies, direct marketing companies and software service providers</li> </ul>
Joint marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Our joint marketing partners may include enrollment and contact centers</li> </ul>

You have the right to correct or amend your personal information that we maintain. If we agree with your request to correct or amend our records, we will correct or amend our records. We can't change personal information other companies provide to us. You'll need to ask them to change it.
